Local Law No. 1 of the year 2010

A Local Law Setting the Date for a Hearing of Real Property Assessment Complaints pursuant to Real Property Tax Law §512

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the

Town of DeKalb as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

The purpose of the Local Law to provide for a grievance day in the Town of DeKalb, which is on a date other than the fourth Tuesday in May due to the fact that the Town of DeKalb shares an Assessor with other taxing jurisdictions.

SECTION 2. AUTHORITY.

The authority to change grievance day is prescribed in Real Property Tax Law §512, subdivision 1(a).

SECTION 3. TEXT.

The Town of DeKalb hereby establishes grievance day as the Wednesday after the fourth Tuesday in May until superceded by another Local Law. This authority is granted pursuant to §512 of the Real Property Tax Law.

SECTION 4.

This Local Law shall become effective upon filing with the Department of State.
